Welcome to the 2016 Paul Bunyan Show, the largest and oldest forest industry Show in the United States.


This 59th showing focuses on education, technology, products, services and entertainment associated with the forest industry.

Many small businesses and homeowners would like to know how they can dry their own lumber as cheaply as possible and solar drying is often the first type of dry kiln considered. OHIO'S FOREST AND FOREST PRODUCTS INDUSTRY SILENT WONDERS OF OUR STATE



Bring up the subject of Ohio forests or wood products in a discussion, and you often get scant stares or have a typically-short conversation. Most people have no idea Ohio even has forests, let alone that they produce forest products, some of which are prized throughout the world.

Yes, Ohio has both a significant amount of forest land as well as a forest products industry which rivals that in many states.

OHIO'S FORESTS ARE THE WOOD SOURCE FOR AN INDUSTRY THAT ADDS MORE THAN \$22 BILLION IN TOTAL ECONOMIC ACTIVITY EACH YEAR TO OHIO'S ECONOMY.

Would you believe that Ohio has 8.2 million acres of forest land, and since World War II, more than 5 million acres of forest have regrown in the state? Approximately 31% of the state, or nearly one in three acres of Ohio, are forest. Forests cover about the same amount of Ohio land as corn and soybeans.

Equally remarkable is these forests, comprised almost entirely of hardwood trees, have a standing inventory of more than 50 billion board feet. Each year, the forests grow almost 2 billion board feet of wood, some of which is harvested (about 500 million board feet each year), some of which dies, and the remainder stays in the woods, allowing the standing inventory to grow by more than a billion board feet each year.

Hardwood species like the white and red oaks, black walnut, black cherry, white ash, yellow poplar and hickory are some of the dozens of species manufactured into various products used in Ohio and shipped throughout the country and to every corner of the globe.

Ohio is especially known for the quality of its hardwood trees that grow so well due to particularly good soils and a favorable climate. Especially valuable logs, lumber and veneer get exported to Asian, European, Middle Eastern, and South American countries which are then manufactured into a host of products used every day throughout the world.

Ohio's forests are the wood source for an industry that adds more than \$22 billion in total economic activity each year to Ohio's economy.

The Ohio forest products industry is comprised of four overall product sectors including **Forestry and Logging, Wood Products, Wood Furniture and Paper Products.**

The **Forestry and Logging Sector** includes businesses and owners that grow forests and harvest the timber for eventual manufacturing. The **Wood Products Sector** processes the logs into lumber and other products like veneer, railroad ties, and dimension and composite timbers. The **Wood Furniture Sector** is a large group of businesses that manufacture sawn and processed lumber into residential, institutional, and business furniture used in almost every facet of our lives. The **Pulp and Paper Sector**, which is the greatest economic impact of the four groups, processes cellulose from wood fiber to manufacture paper, packaging and other cardboard products.

Collectively, these sectors directly employ nearly 48,000 people who earn more than \$2.4 billion per year and add \$12.7 billion in economic activity to the economy. When indirect and induced employment and impacts are combined, more than 118,000 people are employed in Ohio because of forest products.



FORESTRY AND LOGGING

Forestry and Logging directly employs 2,700 people. However, 1,500 more people are employed in Ohio because of these sectors. Total impacts include...

- \$106 million in wages and benefits
- \$212 million in value added
- \$434 million in total economic activity

WOOD PRODUCTS

Wood Products Manufacturing directly employs 13,200 people. However, 14,500 more Ohioans are employed because of these sectors. Total impacts include...

- \$1.12 billion in wages and benefits
- \$1.62 billion in value added
- \$3.72 billion in total economic activity

WOOD FURNITURE

Wood Furniture Manufacturing directly employs 12,200 people. However, 11,700 more Ohioans are employed because of these sectors. Total impacts include...

- \$1.05 billion in wages and benefits
- \$1.51 billion in value added
- \$3.14 billion in total economic activity

PAPER PRODUCTS

Paper Manufacturing is the largest contributor to Ohio's forest economy, directly employing 19,800 people. However, 45,500 more people are employed in Ohio because of these sectors. Total impacts include...

- \$3.50 billion in wages and benefits
- \$5.84 billion in value added
- \$15.15 billion in total economic activity

Among the 50 states in the country:

- Ohio ranks 1st in employment per thousand acres of forest land;
- Ohio is the nation's 2nd largest pallet producer;
- The Ohio paper industry is 4th in the nation in terms of earnings;
- The Ohio "Amish Cluster" produces 10% of the nation's domestic furniture;
- In Ohio, 8% of manufacturing is wood based.

Those are pretty remarkable numbers and strong testament to the economic value and importance of Ohio's forests and the wood products that come from them.

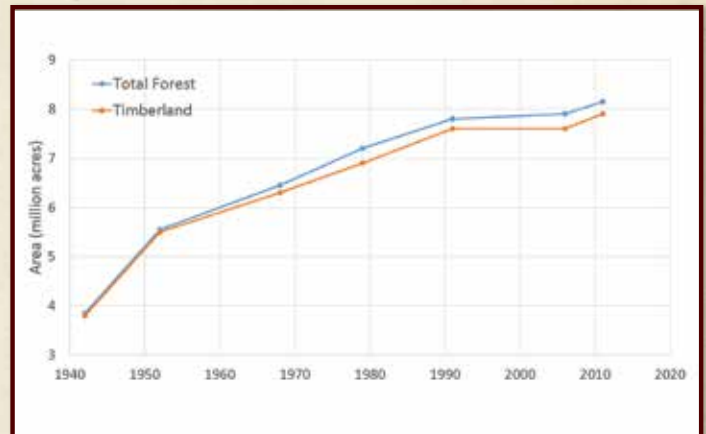

Wood and wood fiber are manufactured into more than 5,000 products that we all use every day, sometimes in products we are not even aware of. And more products and uses continue to be developed through research and new engineering ideas, expanding the world of wood use.

Examples include the use of nanotechnology to make new products from

wood fiber like resins and polymers for a vast array of new products. Architects and engineers are re-thinking the use of wood in tall building construction to create safer and more stable structures that withstand fire and disaster events. The wood adds beauty to the buildings, too.



New products demand more wood and harvesting. But Ohio forests are sustainably grown and harvested, and they have the growing capacity to produce much more wood without ever running out.

The future is bright for wood products and especially for those grown and manufactured in Ohio. The Paul Bunyan Show is an important event, providing business people in forestry and the industry a venue to view and purchase new harvesting and wood manufacturing equipment, which is used to produce the world of wood products we need and want.

2016 OUTDOOR SHOW MAP

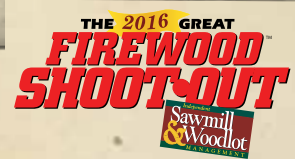
